Kerala nurse in Saudi contracts China virus, 30 more quarantined in hospital



Thiruvananthapuram : At least thirty nurses from Kerala were reportedly quarantined in a hospital in Saudi Arabia after one of them tested positive for deadly coronavirus that claimed several lives in China, said their relatives. After the news surfaced, chief minister Pinarayi Vijayan sent a letter to external affairs minister Jayshankar seeking his immediate intervention. "Reports suggest some nurses working at the Al Hyat Hospital in Abha have contracted the virus. The MEA will have to intervene

to ensure proper treatment and protection for them," he said in the letter. Abha is the capital city of Asir province in southwest Saudi Arabia. The incident came to light after some of the affected nurses called up their relatives back home and complained about their situation. "We have been herded in two rooms of the hospital for more than two days. No proper tests were done and we are not treated properly. We have also complained to Indian Embassy officials," one of them told a Malayalam news channel over the phone.

Minister of State for External Affairs V. Muraleedharan said the condition of the affected patient was stable and embassy officials are monitoring the situation. "More than 100 Indian nurses are working in the hospital and thirty of them are under observation. No fresh case has been reported," he said in Delhi. As per details available, a 38-year-old nurse hailing from Ettumanoor in Kottayam was contracted the virus while treating a Filipino who had tested positive for the deadly virus. Later all nurses who came in contact with the affected nurse were isolated and put under observation. But quarantined nurses said it was a panic reaction and they were isolated without any tests or procedures. "We were told out of 30 nurses swab tests were conducted in 20 and all were tested positive. All of them have been isolated because they have no idea about the incubation period of the virus. Their condition is really pitiable," said one of the relatives who did not want to be identified.

Bihar school has two teachers and a cook for single student



having four classrooms besides a kitchen. The state government pays about Rs 58,000 for the two teachers employed in the school and Rs 1,500 for the cook deputed there. Located about 22 km south from Gaya district, the Mansabigha government primary school, under Khizarsarai police station in Chiraili panchayat is catching attention for the high student-teacher ratio. Mukhiya, Chiraili panchayat, Dhamraja Paswan, said the school was quite old but people in the locality were more inclined towards taking 'quality education' from private schools that are in plenty in the locality. "The whole area has transformed as a market place, so there are many options of private schools for the people, so they shy away from attending the Mansabigha primary school," he said, adding the quality of education imparted by the teachers in government school

was poor, so people have moved to private institutions. He said the Mansabigha village was having about 30-35 houses of upper caste Bhumihars besides 10-12 houses of Paswans. "People want quality education so they prefer private school, instead of government one," said Paswan. The lone, 'pricey' student, Jhanvi Kumari, who is a Paswan by caste, gets special attention of the two teachers. The mid-day meal for her is prepared by a cook Gyanti Devi, who is deputed at the school. "Sometimes the food for her is even brought from nearby hotel to feed her, as preparing for a student sometimes becomes a difficult task," said one of the teacher Priyanka Kumari. She added that altogether nine students were enrolled in the school, but just one attended the classes. "She will also leave the school after sometime," she said. When asked about the syllabus and how her exam was taken, Kumari said, "We teach her to our best ability."

Patna : The low student-teacher ratio has been a problem across the country, however, in Gaya there's a government school that has two teachers for one student, besides there is also a cook who prepares mid-day meal for the lone student. The exchequer has to pay about Rs 59,000 every month for the education of the lone student of class one, who studies in one-storey school building

TMC, Cong, CPI(M) slam BJP leader Kailash Vijayvargiya for his comment on eating habits



State for Parliamentary Affairs Tapas Roy said such racist and communal statements are reflection of BJP's "anti-Bengali" mindset. "We all know that BJP is an anti-Bengali party. Such communal statements only reflect that mindset. BJP and its leaders don't know anything about Bengal, its culture and eating habits and are dreaming of ruling Bengal. They would get a befitting reply for insulting Bengalis," he said. Roy's view were echoed by CPI(M) Politburo member Mohammed Salim, who alleged that BJP is

trying to do a racial profiling of the country. "Just because someone is not eating roti does not make him a Bangladeshi. Poha, which is known as chirey in this part of the country, is a staple diet and is very popular as breakfast food. What is BJP trying to do? They are trying to racially profile the country on the basis of dress code, eating habits and lifestyle," Salim said. He also said Vijayvargiya's comments are "just an extension" of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's remark that those indulging in violence over the citizenship law could be identified by their attire. Modi, while addressing a rally in Jharkhand in December had said people who had set ablaze property during anti CAA protests can be identified by the clothes they wore. Leader of Congress in the Lok Sabha, Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury too criticised Vijayvargiya and said his comments are an "insult to the people of West Bengal".

McDonald's became the first major entity to announce that a select few eateries will be open round the clock in the financial capital under the new rules by the Maharashtra government. All the seven outlets are located in premium malls spread across the city. Its senior director Saurabh Kalra said this will make Mumbai a truly "maximum city". The city, which has a reputation of not sleeping at all, generally relishes on illegal eateries that thrive across neighbourhoods, with egg varieties being a favourite night snack. The Retailers Association of India had in a statement said that employment will increase by 10 per cent in the city because of such a move.
